Nolan Completes Upgrades to Freemark Tasting Room

Nolan Construction completed a remodel of Freemark Abbey's Tasting Room this fall. The landmark winery has added a new tasting bar, an intimate private tasting room and outside patio. Napa Architect James Jeffery selected warm stained red oak and Caesarstone quartz surfaces to enhance the feeling of warmth throughout the project. Detailed attention was given to ceiling beams, walls and hardwood flooring to ensure an updated but aged look in the new reception areas, including a portland cement wash on the trellis framing and special plaster faux finishes on the walls. Updates to the outside ramps, walkways, and entryways make the winery more accessible.

Nolan Construction's Tenant Improvement Group managed the project, with Steven Brown serving as Project Manager, James Nason as Superintendent, and Ginger Magaoay as Project Administrator.
